Montréal, September 13, 2010 – Culture pour tous is very pleased that the *Je m'affiche pour la culture!* project will be taking place in over 20 municipalities across Québec.

During the Journées de la culture, citizens are invited to make their way to one of the 23 participating municipalities: **Baie-Comeau, Beloeil, Blainville, Chambly, Granby, Kamouraska, Larouche, Latulipe-et-Gaboury, Laval, Longueuil, Montréal, Neuville, Percé, Québec, Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts, Sainte-Anne-des-Monts, Sainte-Anne-des-Plaines, Saint-Donat, Saint-Eustache, Shawinigan, Sherbrooke, Sorel-Tracy and Victoriaville.** As part of the event, photo studios will be set up in public spaces, where people can have their photo taken by a professional photographer. Participants will then have to write a short text (140 characters) on the importance of art and culture in their lives. The photos and texts will be featured in an already extensive online gallery at www.jemaffichepouurlaculture.com. Throughout the year, citizens may also send in their photos and texts through the Web site.
